SHOW RULES

- Multiple riders permitted to show one horse, but not to exceed a total of 3 tests/classes per horse per day. Horse can be ridden in 2 consecutive levels.
- Entry fees must be paid in full prior to releasing show packets, including bridle numbers.
- All horses on the grounds must have a stall. Showing out trailers is not permitted.
- Non-compete horses are allowed. Entry form must be filled out showing non-compete fee, office fee and stall fee.
- All horses must wear bridle numbers when out of stall, including non-compete horses.
- All riders MUST wear approved ASTM helmets while mounted. Boots with a heel, shirt/jacket with collar and sleeves required. Western dressage riders must wear show attire; chaps optional.
