Entries: Entries must be postmarked on or before the closing date. Entries postmarked after closing date will be considered post entry and will incur late fees. FOR SPECIAL DELIVERIES, PLEASE SEND ENTRIES WITHOUT A SIGNATURE NEEDED. NO CERTIFIED, REGISTERED, OR EXPRESS MAIL WITH A SIGNATURE NECESSARY FOR RECEIPT WILL BE ACCEPTED. Online entry is available at www.showsecretary.com. You may also mail your paper entry and check to Susan Peacock. Make checks payable to MODA – Mid-Ohio Dressage Association and send with entry to **Show Secretary: Susan Peacock, 837 Glenlake Dr., Edmond, OK 73013**. No post-dated checks accepted. Entries are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis, based on postmark date and entries may be limited. Those entries postmarked after closing will be accepted at the discretion of the show secretary, based on space available and charged a \$25.00 late fee per show. If the classes are oversubscribed, a Waiting List (in order of receipt) will be maintained. Management reserves the right to refuse any entry.

An online convenience fee of 3.5% will be charged on all credit card transactions.

Official Ride Times: Stabling assignments and provisional times will be available to competitors at www.showsecretary.com. In compliance with USEF rule DR126.1.b.3, official times will be posted near the office at noon the day before the competition starts. All change requests must be made by 11:00 am the day PRIOR to the start of the competition.

Refund Policy: Cancellations prior to closing date will be refunded, less office fee(s) and online convenience fees. No refunds will be given after closing date.

Hazardous Weather/Act of God/Accident Policy: Management reserves the right to cancel any classes due to hazardous weather, acts of God, accident, or emergency. Every effort will be made to reschedule with priority given to any qualifying classes being offered. No refunds for cancellations due to hazardous weather, acts of God, accidents, or emergencies.

Schedule: Classes may not necessarily run in the order listed on the prize list. It is the responsibility of the rider to inform the show secretary of any time conflicts as soon as possible after receiving the schedule. Management reserves the right to change officials, limit entries, combine or cancel classes, and modify the schedule, to modify or cancel awards and/or make whatever changes are required by circumstances to the competition specifications listed herein. Show management reserves the right to cancel classes insufficiently filled and to refuse or require withdrawal of any entry for cause deemed sufficient by show management.

Non-compete horses: Non-compete horses are allowed on grounds, if space is available. Owner must fill out entry form and pay office and stall fees.

**** All horses must wear show numbers at all times when out of stall ****

Scores: It is the responsibility of all competitors to verify the accuracy of all scores. Scoring errors must be reported to the Show Secretary within one hour of the official posting of the scores from the last class of the show day during which the score was earned.

Awards: Ribbons will be presented for first through sixth place.

Stabling: Stabling is 10 x 10 permanent with wood/bar walls and solid doors. Groups wishing to be stabled together must all use the same name or group name on the "Stable Group" line of entry form. Every possible effort will be made to honor these requests; however, **no guarantees will be made**. Shavings are **NOT** included with Stabling Fees, and **NO SHAVINGS AVAILABLE ON PREMISES**.

Stall charts will be posted and check-in will begin at 1:00 pm on Friday. Early arrivals and late departures are only available by arrangement with the Show Manager. Stalls must be vacated by 9:00 pm Sunday or the late departure will be charged. Horse or Tack stalls cannot be changed/switched unless you obtain approval from Show Office.

Arenas/Footing/Warm-up: All tests will be ridden in one standard 20M x 60M arena with sand mix footing. The setup will comply with Dressage Level 1 class rules. A warm-up is also available in sand mix footing. Lunging may be available weather dependent. Arenas close at 9:00 pm.

Schooling: Rings will be available for schooling Friday starting at 2:00 pm, and after the show each day. Closing times will be announced each day. There will be a designated lunging area, weather permitting. Other than this designated area, no lunging permitted in any of the show rings at any time.

THERE WILL BE NO SMOKING IN THE BARN, ARENA OR BUILDINGS.

Concessions: There may be a food truck on the grounds. There are a selection of restaurants within 2-3 miles of the grounds.

No portable electric, gas or other type of heater is permitted indoors, tack stalls, or barns.

Helmet/Headgear: From the time horses are officially admitted to the competition grounds by competition management, anyone mounted on a horse at any time on the competition grounds, including non-competing riders, riders on non-competing horses, mounted participants in exhibition classes and those competing in all classes and tests, including Para-Equestrian tests, must wear protective headgear as defined by this rule and otherwise in compliance with GR801. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place. Protective headgear is defined as a riding helmet which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. The harness must be secured and properly fitted.

COVID19 and MODA Schooling Show: Due to the nature of the COVID-19 pandemic, guidelines may change at any time.

- √ Masks are required for everyone except for when mounted on horse.
- √ Anyone on the grounds affirms they do not have an elevated temperature, COVID-19 symptoms or been in contact with any person(s) confirmed or suspected to have COVID-19.
- √ Contact with Show Manager/Secretary must be through text and/or email.
- √ No Spectators.
- √ No congregating in stabling or grounds.
- √ Individuals may be removed from the grounds for violating requirements.

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of the Competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the Competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable-casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the Competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the Competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. Federation Release, Assumption of Risk, Waiver, and Indemnification

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Competition with my horse, as a rider, driver, handler, vaultor, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, or as parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death. ("Harm").

I AGREE to hold harmless and release the Federation and the Competition from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm of any nature caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm arises or results resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the Federation or the Competition.

I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of the Federation or the Competition.

I AGREE to indemnify (that is, to pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred by) the Federation and the Competition and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for Harm to me or my horse, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse while at the Competition. I have read the Federation Rules about protective equipment, including GR801 and if applicable, EV114, and I understand that I am entitled to wear protective equipment without penalty, and I acknowledge that the Federation strongly encourages me to do so while WARNING that no protective equipment can guard against all injuries.
