Divisions Junior: Age 21 or under as of Jan 1, 2020

Senior: Adult Amateur & Open (Anyone over 21 as of Jan 1, 2020)

Awards Ribbons to 8th place.

Classes Split by Junior or Senior divisions but may be combined if entries warrant.

MANDATORY HELMET DUE TO INSURANCE! USEF standards for helmets will be strictly enforced.

Dress code is relaxed. Boots or half-chaps, safe riding shoes with a heel, neat and clean shirt/jacket with a collar. Appropriate western acceptable if worn over a safety helmet.

Volunteers are always needed scribes, scorers, ring stewards, take your pick. We'll work around your ride times. Join the fun and earn tickets for the volunteer raffle. ODS members can also earn \$3 in ODS BUCKS per hour worked; good towards clinics, future show or membership fees.

Information/Fees (Sorry, no refunds after the closing date.)

- **Class Fees** \$35
- **Office Fee** \$25 per entry (horse/rider combination) for the Saturday show ONLY
- **Noncompeting horse** \$35 plus office fee and applicable stabling or haul-in fees
- **Stalls (Stalls are 12x12, rubber matted with full sliding doors. No bedding provided.)**
 - **Schooling Show Stall** \$100 Friday thru Saturday ONLY
 - **Tack stalls** \$75 (weekend- one fee whether showing schooling or both shows)
 - **Weekend Stall for both shows** \$125 (If weekend stalls are paid for on schooling show entry, no additional payment due for Recognized show stalls.)
- **Bedding** \$8 per bag available with pre-order/entry; or \$9 per bag for purchase at the show grounds.
Please pre-purchase to ensure that the bedding is available at the time of your arrival.
- **Haul-in** \$25 per day (those not using a stall and showing out of their trailer)
- **Camper/Electrical Hookup** \$35 per 24-hour period Reservation required, only 6 total spots available. Preference will be given to those entering both the schooling show and the recognized show.
- **Late Entry Fee** \$20 if postmarked after closing date (if room available)
- **Returned Check Fee** \$50

Facilities Show will be held in outdoor rings with a blend of SRS footing outfitted with HITS self-watering system for consistent and concussion minded footing. Lunging is only allowed in designated areas. A 20m by 60m arena will be used for all tests. Food available on grounds; dogs must be on leashes; standard dressage rules apply especially regarding equipment.

Test/class limit – Three USDF/USEF dressage tests per day per horse. Western dressage, equitation, and eventing tests do not count toward this limit. Post scheduling class changes will only be made as the schedule allows.

Ride times and stabling will be available on the website ShowSecretary.com.

OHIO LIABILITY RELEASE AND ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Ohio Dressage Society's DownCenterline shows and/or Ohio Dressage Society hosted or sponsored activities. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horseback riding and equine activities carry inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury. In accordance with the Ohio Equine Liability Act, Ohio Revised Code 2305.321, I do hereby acknowledge the following INHERENT RISKS OF EQUINE ACTIVITIES:

- a) The propensity of an equine to behave in ways that may result in injury, death or loss to person on or around the equine;
- b) The unpredictability of an equine's reaction to sounds, sudden movement, unfamiliar objects, persons, or other animals;
- c) Hazards, including, but not limited to, surface or subsurface conditions;
- d) A collision with another equine, another animal, a person, or an object;
- e) The potential of an equine activity participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury, death, or loss to the person of the participant or to other person, including, but not limited to, failing to maintain control over an equine or failing to act within the ability of the participant.

I AGREE THAT: In consideration of the Ohio Dressage Society allowing my participation in Ohio Dressage Society's DownCenterline shows, Ohio Dressage Society hosted or sponsored activities, and/or any other equine activity, under the terms set forth herein, I, the rider, and the parent or guardian thereof if a minor, do (a) agree to hold harmless and release the Ohio Dressage Society, its agents, volunteers, employees, officers, members, premises owners, affiliated organizations, and insurers from legal liability due to any of their negligence or to the negligence or actions of other riders, auditors, clinicians, or spectators, (b) waive any legal claim I or my minor child or ward named above may have against the Ohio Dressage Society, its agents, volunteers, employees, officers, members, premises owners, affiliated organizations, and Insurers for injuries resulting from any INHERENT RISKS OF EQUINE ACTIVITIES, as described above and in Ohio Revised Code 2305.321, and (c) agree that I am participating in all equine activities hosted, organized, or sponsored by the Ohio Dressage Society at my own risk and assume all risk of damage or injury to my person, horse, or property other than that due to the intentional misconduct of the Ohio Dressage Society. I understand that this waiver will remain effective unless and until revoked by me in writing.
