**Full payment is required when submitting entries. Make checks payable to "ODS".
Incomplete and late entries may be refused. A \$10 incomplete/post entry fee will be charged.
Ride times will be posted by 5pm on the Thursday before the show.**

SHOW RULES:

- Multiple riders permitted to show one horse, but not to exceed a total of 4 tests/5 classes per horse per day. Horse can be ridden in 2 consecutive levels.
- Entry fees must be **paid in full prior to releasing show packets**, including bridle numbers.
- Non-compete horses are allowed. Entry form must be filled out showing non-compete horses.
- All horses must wear bridle number**, including non-compete horses.
- All riders MUST wear approved ASTM/SEI helmets** while mounted. Boots with a heel, shirt/jacket with collar and sleeves are required. Western Dressage riders must wear show attire, chaps optional.
- USEF/USDF Rules will be observed. Refer to www.USDF.org and www.USEF.org.
- USDF 2020 Dressage Tests used. Refer to www.USDF.org

- Current (12 months) negative Coggins is required for all horses brought onto the show grounds. Please send copy with your entry and present original at entrance to facility.
- Stallions **MUST** be attended at all times.
- Dogs, or other pets, are **NOT** allowed on property unless they are a service animal with proper registration and paperwork. This must be presented at entry to facility.
- ALL** Participants **MUST** read **all COVID19 and liability information** and **present signed waivers at entrance**. --ODS Guidelines for Covid 19 --ODS Health and Safety Measures (Attestation)

ALL participants and horses should arrive at facility no more than 1.5 hours prior to scheduled ride time with no more than 2 helpers. Horses and participants should wait at their trailers until their reasonable warm-up time should begin. Participants should depart as soon as possible after their classes have finished. Scores and placings will be available online after close of show. All entries in any particular class may be ridden out of sequence with others in their classes.

Directions: From I-35, exit on 2nd Street/Rt. 66 East in Edmond. Drive east (left at signal), 7 miles to Hiwassee Road. Turn north/left off Rt. 66. Continue 3 miles to E. Sorghum Mill Road (no stop sign). Turn east/right. Continue ¾ mile to High Hill Farm (sign on hill) on the south side/right side of the road.
