Phase 1 - Entries Accepted

1. Entries for the show will be accepted from 9/14/2020 to 9/28/2020
 - a. Complete an entry (online or via the mail)
 - b. A confirmation email will be provided to the rider and owner's email listed on the entry
 - c. This email will contain your PREFILLED CLASS INFORMATION SIGN for use at the beginning of your videoed ride
 - d. Note: No class changes after 9/28/2020

Phase 2 - Videos Submission Accepted

1. Follow the guidelines on page four (4) to video your ride
2. Upload your video(s) to your personal YouTube account, see directions below
 - a. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=l0eM1_JVqHE&list=PL9hW1uS6HUfsHJGacBWVx9yp8jQYHTO-Q&index=2
3. Between 10/1/2020 and 10/19/2020, add the YouTube video links to your video submission form
 - a. A link to your video submission form will arrive in your confirmation email

Phase 3 - Judging and Score Board

1. The judges will provide scores from October 22 through November 5
 - a. ~~When your ride has been judged and your score is available online, you will receive an email from ShowSecretary.com~~
 - b. ~~Another email will be received from ShowSecretary.com when the class is complete, and class placings are available online~~
2. To facilitate the large number of rides to score, posting of scores will be on 11/10/2020
3. A Live Online Award Ceremony will be held November 14, 2020
4. Awards will be mailed after the Online Award Ceremony



Online Show Guidelines

1. Use arenas that are as close to regulation size as possible and be sure letters are set appropriately to be viewed by the judge. Cones with large letters on them and poles on the ground to delineate the corners are acceptable. For arena measurements, please visit this link, <https://westerndressageassociation.org/western-dressage-arena/>
 - a. Intro and Basic must use a 20 x 40 meter arena
 - b. Level 1 through Level 4 must use a 20 x 60 meter arena
 - c. All Freestyles are in a 20 x 60 meter arena
2. Videos of tests must be unedited from start to finish, including the equipment, attire, and bit check. They must be one continuous recording with the horse and rider visible at all times.
3. Videos **must** be filmed in LANDSCAPE orientation.
4. The test must be videoed from behind C, where the judge would normally be seated.
5. Prior to beginning the test, the PREFILLED CLASS INFORMATION SIGN (including the **DATE** filmed) must be videoed for at least 5 seconds. Remove the sign just before the ride begins. The videographer can hold the sign then move back to behind the camera or hold the sign in front of the camera at arm's length while also holding the camera.
6. Keep the horse in frame, paying close attention to the near corners. You may zoom in slightly on the far corners. Videos must be in focus.
7. Make sure to keep the letters in the frame that are elements of the test being performed.
8. As soon as the test is finished, the camera must slowly circle the horse and rider showing all equipment and attire, including spurs and whip if used. If the videographer is unable to enter the arena, at G the rider may turn the horse slowly, wait five seconds, then turn slowly to show the second side, and wait an additional 5 seconds to complete filming of the equipment.
9. Following equipment check, the rider will dismount and show that two fingers can fit between the bosal or cavesson and the horse's cheek, then drop the bit so it can be evaluated. NOTE: Hold the bridle so as not to obscure the curb strap or curb chain. Demonstrate that the curb strap or chain is flexible and is at least ½ inch wide. Make sure the judge can see all parts of the bridle, including bit and reins clearly.
10. Exceptional riders are exempt from the dropping the bit requirement.
11. Coaching during the test is not allowed EXCEPT for WDAA Exceptional Rider tests
12. The natural background sound for the test must be audible. Tests with no sound at all will not be accepted. Freestyles must have music in the background but not digitally added to the video itself.
13. No horse may be ridden more than once in any class.
14. The test may be called.
- 15. The video may not be a ride from a previous show**

PLEASE NOTE – Show Management will review all submissions to ensure adherence to the guidelines as stated above. If a test is submitted that does not comply with these guidelines, Show Management will contact the exhibitor immediately via email or phone. **The exhibitor must submit a replacement video no later than October 19. Those that submit videos near the closing date of Phase 2 and are told they must make a new video will have until noon October 21 to submit a replacement.**

Payment: Entries must be completed online at ShowSecretary.com or entry form (below) must be filled out and mailed with payment to the show secretary by the closing date. Entries submitted by mail risk being delayed which will delay entry submission process. Online entries are highly recommended.

When paying by credit card, cards are only accepted during the online entry phase on www.showsecretary.com. Do not write credit card information on a mailed entry and do not email credit card information to the show secretary.

To enter online, go to www.showsecretary.com. Online entries will incur a 3.5% online convenience fee. Online entries must be completed by the closing date and no class changes can be made after closing date

When submitting entries by mail, the entry will not be accepted until the check arrives to the show secretary and must be from a United States bank with United States funds or cashier's check. A completed online or mailed entry form, and (if applicable) copies of amateur card, and payment online or by check must be received by the show secretary **by 9/28/2020** for an entry to be accepted.

In the event the competition is canceled, Total Entry Fees minus the office fee and online convenience fee (if applicable) will be refunded. D. Special Awards

- **World Show Greenhorn Award** - rider and horse competing for the first time with the highest score. Neither horse nor rider may have ever shown at any WDAA Western Dressage World Championship Show. This Award is for Junior and Amateur riders only. The winner will receive a WDAA award blanket.
- **Exceptional Rider Award** - Buckle goes to highest scoring exhibitor showing in either the Physically Challenged or Therapeutic Rider classes. The winner will receive a WDAA award buckle.

Competition Rules

WDAA Memberships: All owners, and riders **MUST be a member of WDAA** to compete in this show. You may join WDAA at www.westerndressageassociation.org.

Amateur Status: If you are entering amateur classes, you must submit a WDAA DECLARATION OF AMATEUR STATUS form (found below and on the WDAA site). Please read the form and provide needed documents accordingly. If you select option 1 (you possess an “ACTIVE” amateur card from USEF, AQHA, APHA or any other equestrian association), you must also submit a copy of the card. The DECLARATION OF AMATEUR STATUS can be found at the link below:

If you are found to NOT be an amateur, you will forfeit your entries with no refund

Junior Status: Riders are eligible to compete as juniors if they are 17 years of age or less at the beginning of the 2020 competition year (December 1, 2019 – November 30, 2020). [GR 103](#).

Prefilled Class Information Sign: You will be provided with a sign to use at the beginning of the video. A link to this document will be emailed to you and will be available to print out online. The beginning of the video must contain at least 5 seconds of this document.

All decisions of equipment checkers, show secretary, judges and WDAA Board of Directors are final. There is no protest covenant at this non USEF licensed event.

Class Restrictions

- Horses may be ridden by two riders. Each horse/rider combination requires a separate entry with all signatures and emergency contact. [WD 102](#)
- No horse may be ridden in the same class number more than once (even with a different rider) per [WD 102.2](#)
- Horse/rider combinations showing in walk/jog rail classes are not eligible for other rail classes or any test other than Introductory Level (Different horse/rider combinations are eligible for other rail classes and tests)
- Horses may only compete in levels that are adjacent with the same rider. For example, a horse may not be ridden in a basic level test and a level two test UNLESS with a different rider. [WD 102](#).
- A horse may be ridden by a maximum of two riders. [WD 102](#).

Exceptional Rider Classes

Riders entered in “exceptional rider classes” may not cross enter into other classes in the show. Participants must abide by all USEF regulations pertaining to attire, tack and equipment for the recognized show. Reference GR821 for additional information.

Tests: We will be using the 2017 WDAA/USEF Western Dressage tests - www.westerndressageassociation.org

Other: Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current rules and of the current USEF/WESTERN DRESSAGE rules will be judged in accordance therewith.

Entries and Scoring

A. General Information:

Entries must be entered online by the closing date. If paying by check, make checks payable to WDAA. To pay with a credit card, you must use online entry. Please visit www.showsecretary.com for online entry. Every horse/rider team requires a separate entry and will pay a separate office fee.

Do not email the entry form below. The entry form below must be mailed with payment and proof of amateur status (if applicable).

For an entry to be considered complete, you must include the WDAA membership numbers for Owner and Rider. If WDAA membership numbers are not received by 9/28, the entry will not be accepted. No exceptions.

Management reserves the right to change officials, limit entries, combine or cancel classes, and modify the schedule to make whatever changes are required by circumstances to the competition specifications listed herein. Management reserves the right to cancel classes insufficiently filled and to refuse or require withdrawal of an entry for cause deemed enough by Show Management.

B. Tests and Exhibitor Gift

AGREEMENT FOR WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, AND INDEMNITY

For and in consideration of Western Dressage Association of America (“WDAA”) allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, handler, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, judge, official, contractor, staff, trainer or volunteer) in a WDAA sanctioned, licensed or recognized event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities. I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the “Agreement”):

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree to be bound and abide by the rules, regulations, and policies of WDAA as published in the USEF Western Dressage Rules and on the website at <https://westerndressageassociation.org/>, as amended from time to time.

B. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK: I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of equestrian and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any WDAA Event involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases such as COVID-19 or other illness caused by the virus SARS-CoV-2), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including helmets); inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of the WDAA Event organizers and competition management; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers (“Risks”).

EQUINE ACTIVITY LIABILITY ACT WARNING:

CAUTION: HORSEBACK RIDING AND EQUINE ACTIVITIES CAN BE DANGEROUS. RIDE AT YOUR OWN RISK.

C. ASSUMPTION OF RISK: I understand that the aforementioned Risks may be caused in whole or in part or result directly or indirectly from the negligence of my own actions or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the WDAA Events, or the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties defined below, and I hereby voluntarily and knowingly assume all such Risks and responsibility for any damages, liabilities, losses, or expenses that I incur as a result of my participation in any WDAA Events. I also agree to be responsible for any injury or damage caused by me, my horse, my employees or contractors under my direction and control at any WDAA Event.

D. WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNITY: In conjunction with my participation in any WDAA Event, I hereby release, waive and covenant not to sue, and further agree to indemnify (meaning reimburse or pay), defend and hold harmless the following parties: WDAA, WDAA recognized affiliates, members, Event participants (including athletes/riders, coaches, trainers, judges, officials, and other personnel), the Event owner, licensee, and competition managers; the promoters, sponsors, or advertisers of any WDAA

Event; any charity or other beneficiary which may benefit from the WDAA Event; the owners, managers, or lessors of any facilities or premises where a WDAA Event may be held; and all directors, officers, employees, agents, contractors, and volunteers of any of the aforementioned parties (Individually and Collectively, the "Released Parties" or "Event Organizers"), with respect to any liability, claim(s), demand(s), cause(s) of action, damage(s), loss, or expense (including court costs and reasonable attorney fees) of any kind or nature, including without limitation personal injury, wrongful death, property damage (including to any horse), loss of consortium, breach of contract, and premises liability ("Liability") which may arise out of, result from, or relate in any way to my participation in the WDAA Events, including claims for Liability caused in whole or in part by the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties.

E. COMPLETE AGREEMENT AND SEVERABILITY CLAUSE: This Agreement represents the complete understanding between the parties regarding the subject matter of this agreement and no oral representations, statements or inducements have been made apart from this Agreement.
