Volunteers are always needed Contact Megan Huey supPLICANTSacre@yahoo.com if you are interested in volunteering. Lunch will be provided for volunteers working four hours or more. Volunteers can earn \$3 in ODS BUCKS per hour worked. Good towards clinics, future show or membership fees.

Due to COVID-19 the show committee plans to implement social distancing policies at the shows and ShowSecretary.com plans to operate under a CLOSED SHOW OFFICE to help protect exhibitors, staff, and officials.

Some of these policies will include:

- Anyone who exhibits COVID-19 symptoms, has tested positive for COVID-19 within last two weeks, or *has been in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 within the last two weeks or has a temperature above 100. 4° F cannot enter the competition grounds. *Exception: Healthcare personnel who have treated patients using appropriate medical grade PPE during the course of performing professional duties and those individuals who are **fully vaccinated** are exempted from this restriction. Fully Vaccinated – an individual is considered to be fully vaccinated two weeks after their second dose in a 2-dose series (Pfizer, Moderna, etc.), or two weeks after a single-dose vaccine (Johnson & Johnson.)
- Participants and their support crew are required to self-monitor their temperature once daily **prior to entering** the competition grounds. **Support crew is limited to TWO people per horse in addition to the rider. (Junior riders may also have one parent).**
- All participants, including licensed officials and volunteers, must provide emergency contact information and execute an updated Waiver and Release of Liability, Assumption of Risk and Indemnity Agreement required by USEF, as a condition of participation.
- A facemask or face covering is required for all staff, officials, volunteers, service providers, and participants except when mounted per USEF rules and will be strictly enforced or you will be asked to leave the grounds. (Face shields are not considered facemasks or face coverings).
- All individuals must practice social distancing (or physical distancing) at all times while on the competition grounds by staying at least 6 feet (about 2 arms' length) from any person who is not a member of their immediate household, and wear a mask at all times.
- A staff member will patrol the barn areas to remind people to stay six (6) feet apart from each other and to wear masks at all times.
- All entries **must be perfect**. Packets will be secured inside each horse's stall prior to arrival. No office visits will be permitted.
- Scratches and rider/horse changes will be communicated via text, e-mail and/or phone with the show secretary.
- Issues that need staff or official's attention will be initiated by a phone call to the office and, if needed, the appropriate staff or officials will address the item at the exhibitor's stalling area.
- Stalling charts will be created using as much space as possible between barns.
- Competitors are encouraged to not spend extra time at the facility outside of their ride times and time to properly attend to their horses.
- The number of horses in each warmup area will be limited.
- Completed test sheets will be e-mailed directly to competitors after being scored.
- The Competition Organizer has the authority under GR 702.1 and GR914 to remove from the facility any person who does not comply with the regulations and requirements in effect at the competition.

Fees

(no refunds after the closing date.)

- **Class Fees** \$35
- **Office Fee** \$25 per entry (horse/rider combination) for the Saturday show ONLY
- **Noncompeting horse** \$35 plus office fee and applicable stabling or haul-in fees
- **Stalls** (Stalls are 12x12, rubber matted with full sliding doors. No bedding provided.)
 - **Schooling Show Stall** \$100 **Friday thru Saturday ONLY**. No arrivals before noon Friday.
 - **Tack stalls** \$75(weekend- one fee whether showing schooling or both shows)
 - **Weekend Stall for both shows** \$125 (If weekend stalls are paid for on schooling show entry, no additional payment due for recognized show stalls.)
- **Bedding** \$8 per bag available with pre-order/entry. All bedding must be prepurchased.
- **Haul-in** \$25 per horse per day (those not using a stall and showing out of their trailer)
- **Camper/Electrical Hookup** \$35 per 24-hour period. Reservation required. Only 6 spots available. Preference will be given to those entering both the schooling show and the recognized show.
- **Late Entry Fee** \$20 if postmarked after closing date (if show is not full)
- **Returned Check Fee** \$50
- **Post Office Visit Fee** \$30 will be added to your mailed entry if it requires a signature

Facility/Tests/Entry Information

Facilities All tests will be held in 20 X 60 outdoor rings with a blend of SRS footing outfitted with HITS self-watering system for consistent and concussion minded footing. Lungeing is only allowed in designated areas. Food NOT available on grounds. No cooking/grilling is allowed on the premises. Dogs must be on leashes.

USDF/USEF Tests 2019 version. **USEA Tests** 2018 version.

WDAA Tests 2017 WDAA/USEF Western Dressage tests for both nongaited and gaited horses, which are available at www.westerndressageassociation.org.

Post scheduling class changes will only be made if schedule allows.

Ride times and stabling will be available on the website ShowSecretary.com.

Scores will be posted at ShowSecretary.com as rides are completed.

Two options to enter:

- 1.) **Online entry credit cards are only method of payment.** A 3.5% convenience fee will be added to total your fees. www.showsecretary.com
- 2.) **Mailed entry only checks or money orders, payable to ODS, are accepted. For security, NO CREDIT CARDS accepted for mailed entries. Mailed entry must be postmarked by the closing date.**

E-mailed entries will NOT be accepted.

Checks will be deposited upon receipt. Dishonored checks or declined credit cards will require complete repayment prior to the show plus a service charge of \$50. All outstanding fees must be paid before show packets are issued.

Divisions Open (w/t/c) or Gaited. Divisions will be split out for placings but may be combined if entries warrant.

- Horses may be ridden by two riders. Each horse/rider combination requires a separate entry with all signatures and emergency contact. [WD 102](#)
- No horse may be ridden in the same class number more than once (even with a different rider) per [WD 102.2](#)
- Horses who have shown in Western Hack are no longer eligible for Western Suitability.
- Horse/rider combinations showing in walk/jog rail classes are not eligible for other rail classes or any test other than Introductory Level (Different horse/rider combinations are eligible for other rail classes and tests)
- Horses may not compete in more than 6 tests per day.
- Horses may only compete in levels that are adjacent with the same rider. For example, a horse may not be ridden in a basic level test and a level two test UNLESS with a different rider. [WD 102.](#)
- A horse may be ridden by a maximum of two riders. [WD 102.](#)
- The open division is for all nongaited horses regardless of breed and all riders regardless of age or status (professional, adult amateur, or youth.)
- The gaited division is for all gaited horses regardless of breed and all riders regardless of age or status (professional, adult amateur, or youth.)
- Nongaited and gaited horses compete together in the suitability and equitation rail classes as well as classes 1I4TOC and 2I4TOC.

I am fully aware and acknowledge that horseback riding and equine activities carry inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury. In accordance with the Ohio Equine Liability Act, Ohio Revised Code 2305.321, I do hereby acknowledge the following INHERENT RISKS OF EQUINE ACTIVITIES:

- a) The propensity of an equine to behave in ways that may result in injury, death or loss to person on or around the equine;
- b) The unpredictability of an equine's reaction to sounds, sudden movement, unfamiliar objects, persons, or other animals;
- c) Hazards, including, but not limited to, surface or subsurface conditions;
- d) A collision with another equine, another animal, a person, or an object;
- e) The potential of an equine activity participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury, death, or loss to the person of the participant or to other person, including, but not limited to, failing to maintain control over an equine or failing to act within the ability of the participant.

I AGREE THAT: In consideration of the Ohio Dressage Society allowing my participation in Ohio Dressage Society's DownCenterline shows, Ohio Dressage Society hosted or sponsored activities, and/or any other equine activity, under the terms set forth herein, I, the rider, and the parent or guardian thereof if a minor, do (a) agree to hold harmless and release the Ohio Dressage Society, its agents, volunteers, employees, officers, members, premises owners, affiliated organizations, and insurers from legal liability due to any of their negligence or to the negligence or actions of other riders, auditors, clinicians, or spectators, (b) waive any legal claim I or my minor child or ward named above may have against the Ohio Dressage Society, its agents, volunteers, employees, officers, members, premises owners, affiliated organizations, and insurers for injuries resulting from any INHERENT RISKS OF EQUINE ACTIVITIES, as described above and in Ohio Revised Code 2305.321, and (c) agree that I am participating in all equine activities hosted, organized, or sponsored by the Ohio Dressage Society at my own risk and assume all risk of damage or injury to my person, horse, or property other than that due to the intentional misconduct of the Ohio Dressage Society.
