

COVID-19 PROTOCOLS
GAIG/USDF Reg 2 Dressage Championships & KDA Fall Classic I
EFFECTIVE MONDAY OCTOBER 4 - SUNDAY OCTOBER 10, 2021

**PLEASE NOTE THAT THESE PROTOCOLS MAY CHANGE IN RESPONSE TO ANY LOCAL, STATE ,
OR NATIONAL REQUIREMENTS.**

WAIVERS: All participants, Licensed officials, and volunteers must provide emergency contact information and execute a USEF Waiver and Release of Liability, Assumption of Risk, and Indemnity Agreement.

SELF-MONITORING REQUIRED: All persons entering the Competition Grounds are required to self-monitor their temperature daily.

No person with a temperature exceeding 100.4 may enter the Competition Grounds

No person exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms may enter the Competition Grounds

No person who has tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 10 days may enter the Competition Grounds

No person who has tested positive outside of the past 10 days; BUT IS STILL SYMPTOMATIC OF COVID-19, may enter the Competition Grounds

No person who has been EXPOSED OR IN CLOSE CONTACT with a positive or symptomatic individual may enter Competition Grounds

EXCEPTION: FULLY VACCINATED PERSONS ARE EXEMPT FROM THIS EXPOSURE QUARANTINE. LIKEWISE, HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONAL WHO HAVE TREATED PATIENTS USING APPROPRIATE MEDICAL GRADE PPE ARE ALSO EXEMPT.

MASKING REQUIREMENTS: This competition encourages that masks be worn in all indoor settings on the Competition Grounds where social distancing is not feasible or possible. Masks are required in ALL RESTROOM AREAS THAT ARE PERMANENT FACILITIES.

SOCIAL DISTANCING: This competition encourages all participants, spectators, officials, and volunteers to practice social distancing at all times.

For purposes of these requirements; "COMPETITION GROUNDS" SHALL BE DEFINED AS ANY AREA WITHIN THE KENTUCKY HORSE PARK THAT IS UNDER RENTAL CONTRACT BY THE COMPETITION, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, ARENAS, STABLING, PARKING LOTS, CONCESSION AREAS, AND OFFICES.

SHOW OFFICE: The show office will be closed to in-person visits. All communication will be handled via radio, phone, or text with the show office. 405-760-0315.

SPECTATORS: Spectators are permitted on competition grounds. All COVID-19 policies apply to spectators and are expected to be followed while on-site.

REPORTING REQUIREMENTS: Any person at the competition who tests positive for COVID-19 during; or within 14 days of the competition conclusion (October 24, 2021), is required to report the positive test to the competition organizer and USEF:
