



VIDEO REQUIREMENTS FOR YOUR EQUIPMENT CHECK

In order for your equipment to be checked and your ride submitted to the judges, it must be in compliance with the following:

- 1) The prefilled ride sign **must** be in focus and for the correct ride.
- 2) The video must be clear and close enough so that we can accurately see your tack.
- 3) The video must be filmed in landscape (horizontal) mode, not portrait (vertical) mode.
- 4) After your ride, the camera should be walked completely around the horse, or the horse must walk to the camera and slowly turn showing both sides.
- 5) If you are wearing spurs, have the camera focus on them for a count of three seconds. No need to spin your rowels.
- 6) Show your bridle on your horse from both sides.
- 7) You **must** dismount prior to dropping your bridle.
- 8) Hold your cavesson up and show us the inside as well. Hold it still and make sure it is within the camera frame.
- 9) Show us your bit. Hold it still and make sure the view is close enough so that we can accurately see the bit.
- 10) Do the same for your curb strap or chain.
- 11) If you are using a bosal, you must drop that as well. After you remove the bosal, show us both sides of your horse's face as well as the bosal.
- 12) Exceptional riders are exempt from the bit dropping requirement and are not required to dismount. Participants should still abide by all USEF regulations pertaining to attire, tack, and equipment for the recognized show. Reference GR120 for additional information.

Look at your video after you have completed it. Is it in compliance with the above rules? Is it clear? Have you shown us your tack for a long enough time and in a close enough range so that we can correctly evaluate your equipment?

If the ride is not able to be evaluated fairly, or if you are found to be using tack that is not legal, you will be notified via email. At that time, you will be advised of the issues that need correction. You will have until June 20 to resubmit the ride. If the ride has not been corrected and resubmitted by the deadline, it will not go on to the judges and you will be eliminated.
