Entries: Entries must be postmarked on or before the closing date. Entries postmarked after closing date will be considered post entry and will incur late fees. FOR SPECIAL DELIVERIES, PLEASE SEND ENTRIES WITHOUT A SIGNATURE NEEDED. NO CERTIFIED, REGISTERED, OR EXPRESS MAIL WITH A SIGNATURE NECESSARY FOR RECEIPT WILL BE ACCEPTED. Entries are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis, based on postmark date and entries may be limited. Those entries postmarked after closing will be accepted at the discretion of the show secretary, based on space available basis and charged a \$25.00 late fee per show. If the classes are oversubscribed, a Waiting List (in order of receipt) will be maintained. Management reserves the right to refuse any entry.

JR/YR Division: Riders must be under 21 as of January 1, 2022 to compete in the JR/YR division.

Official Ride Times: Stabling assignments and provisional times will be available to competitors at www.showsecretary.com.

Refund Policy: Cancellations prior to closing date will be refunded, less office fee(s) and online convenience fees. No refunds will be given after closing date.

<u>Hazardous Weather/Act of God/Accident Policy:</u> Management reserves the right to cancel any classes due to hazardous weather, acts of God, accident, or emergency. Every effort will be made to reschedule with priority given to any qualifying classes being offered. No refunds for cancellations due to hazardous weather, acts of God, accidents, or emergencies.

<u>Schedule:</u> Classes may not necessarily run in the order listed on the prize list. It is the responsibility of the rider to inform the show secretary of any time conflicts as soon as possible after receiving the schedule. Management reserves the right to change officials, limit entries, combine or cancel classes, and modify the schedule, to modify or cancel awards and/or make whatever changes are required by circumstances to the competition specifications listed herein. Show management reserves the right to cancel classes insufficiently filled and to refuse or require withdrawal of any entry for cause deemed sufficient by show management.

Helmets: Protective headgear is required for all riders.

<u>Scores:</u> It is the responsibility of all competitors to verify the accuracy of all scores. Scoring errors must be reported to the Show Secretary within one hour of the official posting of the scores from the last class of the show day during which the score was earned.

Dogs: Well-mannered dogs on leashes or in crates are welcome.

- You do not need to be a member of any organization to compete at this schooling show. All breeds are welcome!
- Bridle numbers must be displayed at all times.
- Lunging is only allowed in marked lunging area.

I AGREE THAT: I choose to participate voluntarily in the Mid-Ohio Dressage Association (MODA) East Meets West Show. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horseback riding and equine activities carry inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss and serious bodily injury. In accordance with the Ohio's Equine Liability Act, Ohio Revised Code 2305.321, I do hereby acknowledge the following INHERENT RISKS OF EQUINE ACTIVITIES:

- a. The propensity of an equine to behave in ways that may result in injury, death, or loss to persons on or around the equine;
- b. The unpredictability of an equine's reaction to sound, sudden movement, unfamiliar objects, person or other animals;
- c. Hazards, including, but not limited to, surface or subsurface conditions;
- d. A collision with another equine, another animal, a person or an object;
- e. The potential of an equine activity participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury, death, or loss to the person of the participant or to other persons, including, but not limited to, failing to maintain control over an equine or failing to act within the ability of the participant.

I AGREE THAT: in consideration of the Mid-Ohio Dressage Association allowing my participation in Mid-Ohio Dressage Association's hosted or sponsored activities, and/or any other equine activity, under the terms set forth herein, I, the rider, and the parent or guardian thereof if a minor, do (a) agree to hold harmless and release the Mid Ohio Dressage Association, its, agents, volunteers, employee, officers, member, premises owner, affiliated organizations and insurers from legal liability due to any of their negligence or the negligence or actions of other riders, auditors, clinicians or spectators, (b) waive any legal claim I or my minor child or ward named below may have against the Mid-Ohio Dressage Association, its agents, volunteers, employees, officers, members, premises owners, affiliated organizations and Insurers for injuries resulting from any INHERENT RISKS OF EQUINE ACTIVITIES, as described above in Ohio Revised Code 2305.321, and (c) agree that I am participating in all equine activities hosted, organized or sponsored by Mid-Ohio Dressage Association at my own risk and assume all risk of damage or injury to my person, horse, or property other than that due to the intentional misconduct of the Mid-Ohio Dressage Association. AGREEMENT

READ THIS AGREEMENT CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING IT, YOUR SIGNATURE INDICATES THAT YOU UNDERSTAND IT AND AGREE TO ITS TERMS. BY SIGNING THIS AGREEMENT YOU (AND YOUR CHILD) ARE GIVING UP CERTAIN LEGAL RIGHTS, INCLUDING THE RIGHT TO SUE OR RECOEVER DAMAGES IN CASE OF INJURY, DEATH OR PROPERTY DAMAGES, FOR ANY REASON, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE STABLE, ITS OWNER, EMPLOYEES AND AGENTS (THE "RELEASEES").

In consideration for allowing me (or my minor child) to handle and ride a horse and on behalf of myself, my child or our personal representatives, heirs, next-of-kin, spouses and assigns: I HEREBY:

- 1. Acknowledge that a horse may, without warning or any apparent cause, buck, stumble, trip, roll, fall, rear, bite, kick, run, make unpredictable movements, spook, jump obstacles, step on a person's feet, push or shove a person, saddle or bridles may loosen or break all of which may cause the rider to fall to the ground to be jolted, resulting in serious injury or death.
- 2. ACKNOWLEDGE THAT HORSEBACK RIDING IS AN INHERENTLY DANGEROUS ACTIVITY AND INVOLVES RISKS THAT MAY CAUSE SERIOUS INJURY AND IN SOME CASES DEATH, because of the unpredictable nature and irrational behavior of horses, regardless of the extent of their training and past performance.
- Voluntarily assume all of the risk and danger of injury or death inherent in the handling or riding of the horse, and use of saddles, bridles, equipment and gear provided by the Releasees.
- 4. Release, discharge and promise not to sue the Releasees for any loss, damage, injury (including death) or cost to me or my child's person or property arising out of riding or handling a horse, or use of saddles, bridles, equipment or gear provided by Releasees.
- 5. Release the Releasees from any claim that the Releasees were negligent in connection with my or my child riding a horse, including but not limited to, training or selecting horses, maintenance, care, fit or adjusting of saddles or bridles, instruction on riding skills or leading and supervising riders, which results in loss, damage, injury or death.
- 6. Indemnify, and save and hold harmless the Releasees from and against any loss, liability, damage or cost they may incur arising out of or in any way connected with either my or my child's handling or riding the horse and/or use of any saddles, bridles, equipment or gear provided therewith resulting from or contributed to by my own negligence.

- 7. Expressly agree that the foregoing release and assumption of risk, and indemnity agreement is governed by the laws of the State of Ohio and is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by Ohio law, and that in the event any portion of this Agreement is determined to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the balance of the Agreement shall not be affected or impaired in any way and shall continue in full legal force and effect.
- 8. Acknowledge that this document is a contract and agree that if a lawsuit is filed against the Releasees for any injury or damage in breach of this contract, I will pay all attorneys fees and costs incurred by the Releasees in defending such an action.
- 9. IT IS REQUIRED THAT I, MY CHILD AND ALL RIDERS WEAR A PROTECTIVE HELMET. IT IS MY UNDERSTANDING THAT A PROTECTIVE HELMET IS AVAILABLE AND HAS BEEN OFFERED FOR MY OWN OR MY CHILD'S SAFETY.
- 10. If the person who is to enter into this Agreement is under eighteen (18) years of age, his/her parent or guardian must read this Agreement and sign below on behalf of the minor.
- 11. No dogs are allowed at the farm without a leash.
