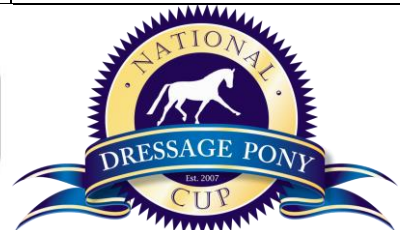

1ES		Egg and Spoon	Open	\$5
Riders will carry a spoon holding an egg. The rider to keep their egg in the spoon longest will win. Class will begin with walk, change of direction, halt, and will progress in difficulty to trot, sitting trot, canter, drop stirrups, etc.				
1BB		Beverage Balance	Open	\$5
Riders will carry a cup of water filled with equal volumes. Riders will be instructed to walk, change direction, halt, posting trot, and sitting trot. At the end of the class the rider with the most water left in the cup will be the winner.				
1SN		Snail Race	Open	\$5
Riders will pick up a canter at a designated letter in the dressage arena. They will be timed from the start letter to a designated finish letter (approx. 40-60 meters). Riders with the LONGEST time from start to finish will win. Penalty for trot steps at judge's discretion.				
1SH		Showmanship for Rookies	Open	\$5
Competitors will be asked to perform simple movements from the ground. This may include walking, backing, turning, trotting. Competitors may also be asked horse-related questions. This class is suitable for those with minimal horse experience!

Ride to your own music. Maximum time is 4 minutes. Not specific to level and any movements are allowed. Costume encouraged!

Entries: Entries must be postmarked on or before the closing date. Entries postmarked after closing date will be considered post entry and will incur late fees. FOR SPECIAL DELIVERIES, PLEASE SEND ENTRIES WITHOUT A SIGNATURE NEEDED. NO CERTIFIED, REGISTERED, OR EXPRESS MAIL WITH A SIGNATURE NECESSARY FOR RECEIPT WILL BE ACCEPTED. Online entry is available at www.showsecretary.com. You may also mail your paper entry and check to Susan Peacock.

Make checks payable to MODA – Mid-Ohio Dressage Association and send with entry to **Show Secretary: Susan Peacock, 837 Glenlake Dr., Edmond, OK 73013.**

No post-dated checks accepted. Entries are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis, based on postmark date and entries may be limited. Those entries postmarked after closing will be accepted at the discretion of the show secretary, based on space available basis and charged a \$30.00 late fee per show. If the classes are oversubscribed, a Waiting List (in order of receipt) will be maintained. Management reserves the right to refuse any entry.

Vaccination & Coggins: Records must be uploaded or mailed with your show entry in order for your entry to be accepted. A negative Coggins (EIA) Report listing the horse's recorded show name within one year of show dates is required for all horses on the grounds, including haul-ins. Show numbers will not be assigned without negative Coggins.

Official Ride Times: Provisional times will be available to competitors at www.showsecretary.com. Please inform the Show Secretary of any time conflicts as soon as possible after receiving provisional ride times.

Refund Policy: Cancellations prior to closing date will be refunded, less office fee(s) and online convenience fee, if applicable. No refunds will be given after closing date.

Hazardous Weather/Act of God/Accident Policy: Management reserves the right to cancel any classes due to hazardous weather, acts of God, accident, or emergency. Every effort will be made to reschedule with priority given to any qualifying classes being offered. No refunds for cancellations due to hazardous weather, acts of God, accidents, or emergencies.

Schedule: Classes may not necessarily run in the order listed on the prize list. It is the responsibility of the rider to inform the show secretary of any time conflicts as soon as possible after receiving the schedule. Management reserves the right to change officials, limit entries, combine or cancel classes, modify the schedule, modify or cancel awards and/or make whatever changes are required by circumstances to the competition specifications listed herein. Show management reserves the right to cancel classes insufficiently filled and to refuse or require withdrawal of any entry for cause deemed sufficient by show management.

JR/YR Division: Riders must be under 21 as of January 1, 2024 to receive JR/YR pricing.

Lead Line: Individual leading the horse/pony must be 18 years of age or older. The leading rein should be attached to the cavesson, noseband, or halter while leaving control of the horse to the rider. Rider must wear a shoe with a heel and their feet must be in the stirrups. Riders and handlers must comply with helmet rules. Stallions may not participate in the leadline class.

Helmets: Protective headgear is required for all riders any time mounted.

Scores: It is the responsibility of all competitors to verify the accuracy of all scores. Scoring errors must be reported to the Show Secretary within one hour of the official posting of the scores from the last class of the show day during which the score was earned.

Championship Classes: Championship classes will be offered at the highest level of each class on Sunday. No qualification scores required. Competitors may enter both the standard class and the championship class.

Awards: Ribbons will be given through six places in each division for classical and western dressage classes. Champion and reserve champion ribbons will be awarded in each division to those electing to compete in championship classes on Sunday. Special prizes will be awarded for fun classes.

National Dressage Pony Cup (NDPC) Awards: A champion ribbon will be awarded to the small horse and pony with the highest score from a classical dressage test. A reserve champion ribbon will be awarded to the small horse and pony with the second highest score from a classical dressage test. (USDF/USEF/FEI classes from Saturday or Sunday, excluding equitation, sport horse in-hand, and freestyle)

TIP Awards: Thoroughbred Incentive Program awards sponsored by The Jockey Club are being offered at this show in the following categories:

- Overall High Score for classical dressage (USDF/USEF/FEI classes, excluding equitation, sport horse in-hand, and freestyle)
- Overall High score for western dressage (WDAA classes, excluding suitability, hack, and equitation)

Year End Awards: Members of MODA are eligible for year-end awards in both Classical and Western Dressage. MODA awards a Classical and Western Crossover buckle for the horse and rider pair with the highest scores at the same level in both disciplines.

Non-compete horses: Non-compete horses are welcome if space permits. Owner is required to complete an entry form and pay all applicable fees.

Show Rules: All classes will be conducted in accordance with the rules of WDAA. All decisions made by the Judge and/or Show Management are final and cannot be protested. Show Management reserves the right to ask any exhibitor to leave the show grounds for any reason, including but not limited to unsportsmanlike conduct and animal cruelty. Management reserves the right to combine or cancel classes, vary or add officials.

Breaking Scoring Ties: In the case of a scoring tie, ties will be broken per the USEF WD127.

Stabling: Groups wishing to be stabled together must all use the same name or group name on the "Stable Group" line of entry form. Every possible effort will be made to honor these requests; however, **no guarantees will be made**. Stall charts will be posted, and check-in will begin at 5:00 pm on Friday. Stalls must be vacated by 1 hour after the last ride on Sunday. Horse or Tack stalls cannot be changed/switched unless you obtain approval from Show Office.

Class/Test Limit: Each horse can be entered in no more than 4 classes total per day and with no more than 2 different riders each day. Horses may only be shown at 2 consecutive levels. Fun classes are excluded.

Facility Information: Brave Horse Show Park stabling consists of 10' x 12' permanent stalls with stall doors and matted concrete floors. Initial bedding will not be provided. If you need shavings, please pre-order. No straw, paper, cardboard, or corn cob bedding allowed, only shavings. No nails or screws allowed in stalls. All of Brave Horse Show Park's five brand new, state of the art arenas are dressed with Footing First's scientifically tested proprietary blend of SRS footing. Management reserves the right to use the small 20 x 40 meter arena if schedule warrants it.

Participant Conduct: The Mid Ohio Dressage Association will not tolerate rude or disrespectful behavior toward show management, officials, competitors or volunteers. Such behavior will result in the offender being told to vacate the facility by whatever means are necessary.

Coaches are encouraged to use electronic communication devices at this competition. If an electronic communication device is not used, the voice, when coaching, may not be heard at the judges' box or competition rings. This applies not only when coaching but during any communication on the grounds. Only the official PA system is to be used as a public broadcasting communication device.

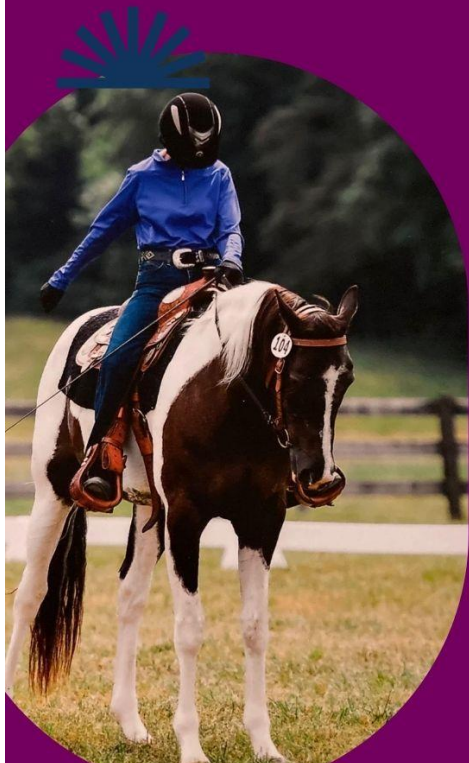
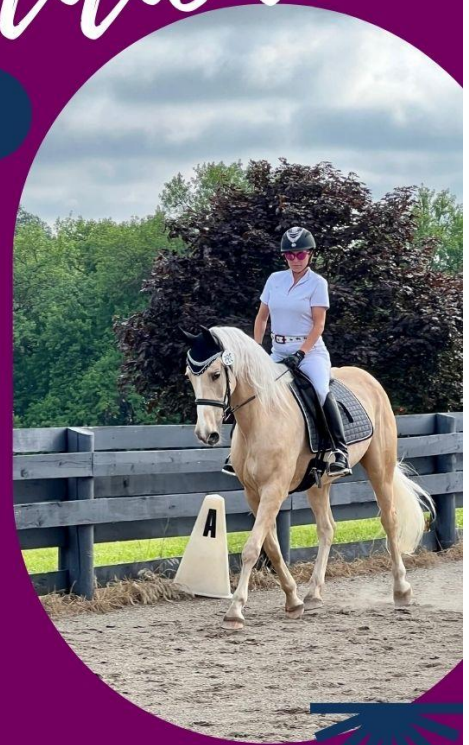
- You do not need to be a member of any organization to compete at this schooling show. All breeds are welcome!
- Bridle numbers must be displayed at all times.
- This show will be governed by USEF Western Dressage rules, WDAA rules, and AQHA rules.
 - In accordance with these rules WDAA exhibitors will be subject to horse, tack, and attire check of at least one-third of the entrants. This check will occur after the test outside of the arena. Any horse must be eliminated from the test if a horse or any tack is in violation of the rules.
- Exhibitors competing for WDAA points:
 - Must be WDAA members and include their owner and rider WDAA numbers on the entry form.
 - WDAA classes, to compete as an adult amateur (AA) you must have a USEF/WDAA amateur card, otherwise you must show in the open division.
 - WDAA members are responsible for submitting their own test results to WDAA per their rules.
 - 2022 WDAA/USEF Western Dressage tests will be used. These are available at www.westerndressageassociation.org
- Exhibitors competing for AQHA points both Traditional and Western Dressage
 - There is an AQHA processing fee per horse/rider combination each day
 - To be eligible, the horse must be AQHA registered, and the exhibitor must have a current AQHA individual membership.
 - Open, amateur and youth eligibility based on criteria found in the AQHA Official Handbook (free at AQHA.com)
 - Eligibility can be found under rules SHW215, SHW 220, SHW 225, and SHW 235
 - Horse registration number and exhibitor membership number must be on the entry form. Exhibitors are responsible for the accuracy of their entries.
 - A photocopy of the horse's papers (front and back) as well as a photocopy of the AQHA exhibitor 2022 membership card must be provided at the time of bridle number pick-up. These copies will not be returned.
- Exhibitors of TRADITIONAL dressage AQHA horses must pay an AQHA competition license fee of \$85.
 - This fee is for the lifetime of the horse. Proof of license is required with entry.
 - All AQHA rules for Traditional Dressage and Western Dressage are available in the 2022 AQHA rulebook SHW 680 and SHW 682.
 - AQHA horses will not run in a separate class. Their test and their scores will be separated out for the purpose of submission to AQHA.
 - AQHA points are offered beginning at the Training/Basic Level. Introductory and Intro levels are not eligible for AQHA points.



Team Competition

Saturday, 9/7

Rules: A team will consist of 2-3 riders. Only 1 open rider (professional) per team. Team members may compete in classical or western dressage classes.* Teams will be declared upon check in at the show office. Teams must be determined before the show begins on Saturday.



Placings: The average of the top 2 scores from 2 separate competitors on the team will determine the team score. Teams will be placed according to their team score. Special prizes will be awarded!
